

A Brief History

The USS POTOMAC was first commissioned "The Coast Guard Cutter Electra", 165 B class, on June 30, 1934. She was subsequently re-commissioned "The USS POTOMAC" in 1936, after being chosen to become the Presidential Yacht.

The POTOMAC is 165 feet in length and has a beam of 25 feet and 3 inches. Her displacement is 416 tons and the draft is 10 feet.

Her engines are two 440 hp. Enterprise Diesels, water cooled. Her cruising speed is between 10 to 13 knots with a 3,000 mile radius. Fuel capacity is 7,700 gallons.

In 1936 the crew totaled 54 to sail and serve the President. Today we sail with 5 Coast Guard certified crew members for up to 120 passengers.

Her very first Commanding Officer was Lt. A. G. Hall who served from October 1934 to April 1935.
